5 weeks and receive a book!!

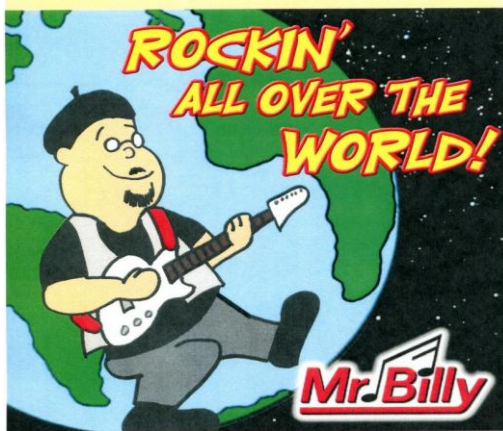
\*Starting Monday, June 13, we will have
